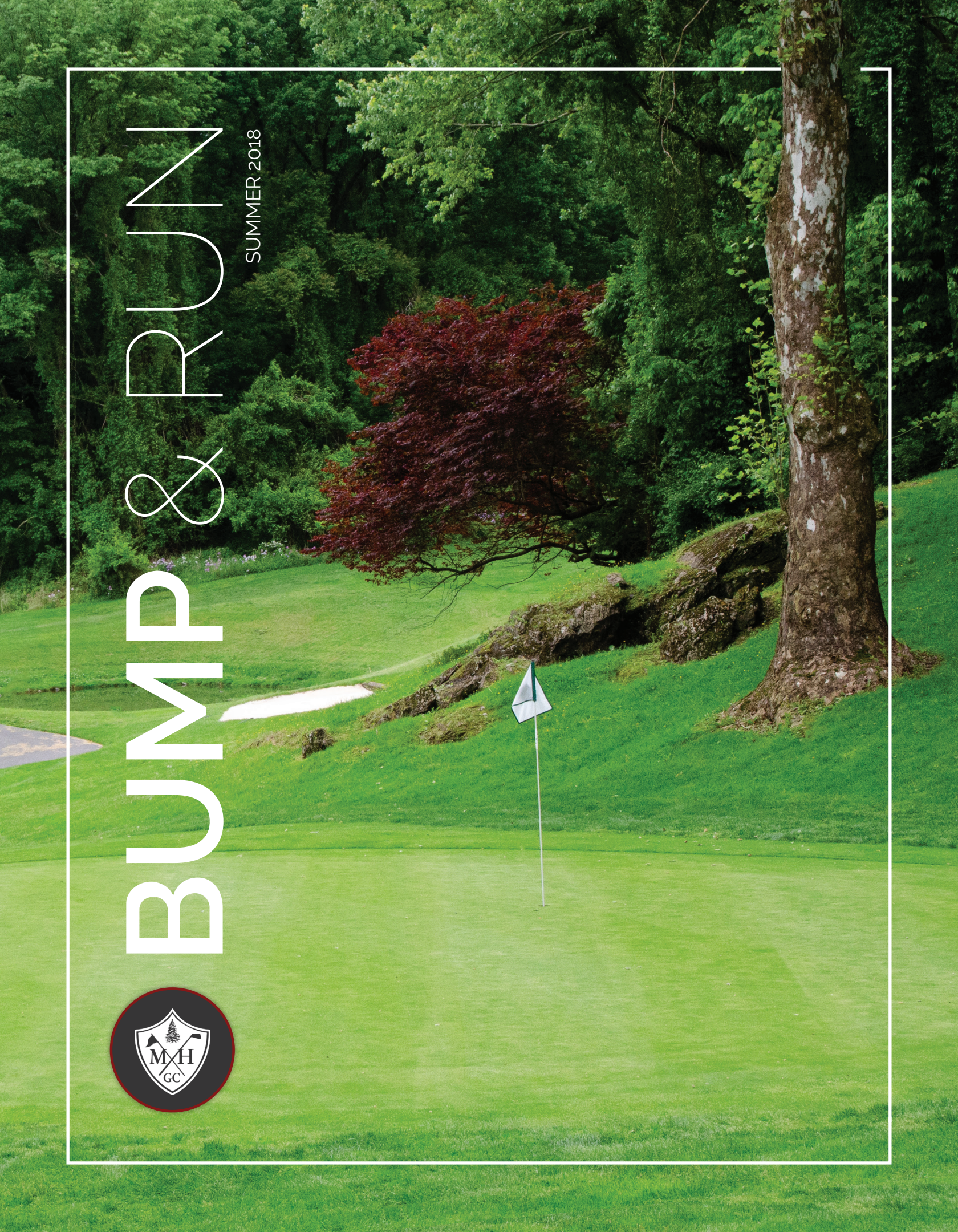

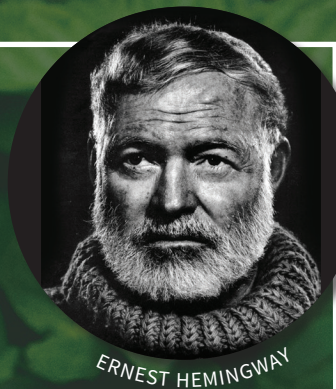

FEATURED DRINK

MOJITO

Widely speculated to be Ernest Hemingway's favorite drink, this refreshing cocktail originated in Havana, Cuba. Great for outdoor barbeques on a hot summer day, it is also the perfect beverage to sip while sitting on the deck at your favorite club (hint, hint).



ERNEST HEMINGWAY

RECIPE

- 2–3 lime wedges
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 7–10 mint leaves
- 2 oz Bacardi Superior white rum
- Splash of Sprite
- Cubed ice

DIRECTIONS

1. In a cocktail shaker, combine sugar, mint leaves, and lime wedges.
2. Muddle so that the mint leaves are crushed and the sugar has dissolved into the lime juice.
3. Add cubed ice and Bacardi.
4. Pour back and forth into a Collins glass to ensure ingredients are mixed well.
5. Keep mixture in the Collins glass and top with ice and Sprite.

VARIATIONS

Try one of these international twists on the traditional mojito recipe.

French Mojito: Add half an ounce of raspberry liqueur in addition to the rum. *À votre santé!*

Italian Mojito: Add half an ounce of Campari in addition to the rum, then top the finished cocktail with an ounce of Prosecco instead of the Sprite. *Cin cin!*

Swedish Mojito: Use Svedka Clementine vodka instead of rum. *Skål!*



MEADIA HEIGHTS CLUB UPDATES

We are undergoing renovations totaling \$1.5 million to improve the Meadia Heights Golf Club experience! Here's a summary of what we've accomplished so far and a sneak peek at what's ahead.

2018 IMPROVEMENTS COMPLETED IN THE LAST SIX MONTHS:

- New six-beer tap system (with two nitro taps) featuring Miller Lite, Yuengling Lager, Guinness (on nitro), and three rotating local brews
- IT infrastructure with new Wi-Fi, cables, and routers
- Five new golf course mowers
- Tree removal and maintenance
- Complete renovation of ballroom
- New dinnerware, furniture, and light fixtures
- Roof repair to the 19th Hole and rear deck, and new roof on clubhouse
- Rebuilding half of the bunkers
- Repaving the cart paths and parking lots
- Beginning of a five-year landscape improvement plan
- Renovated outdoor dining deck

Total investment: \$750,000

2019 PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS FROM WINTER 2018 TO SPRING 2019:

- Entire renovation of the 19th Hole
- Expanded outdoor deck with propane fire pits
- All-terrain vehicles (ATVs) for groundskeepers
- Additional new golf course equipment
- Continued bunker rebuilds
- Rain drainage system for the greens on holes 5, 10, 15, and 18
- Taller driving range net
- Driving range mats
- Power washing and painting the clubhouse
- New club management software system
- Additional tree maintenance
- Additional landscaping

Total investment: \$750,000

If you dropped in on them at home unexpectedly, they would be...

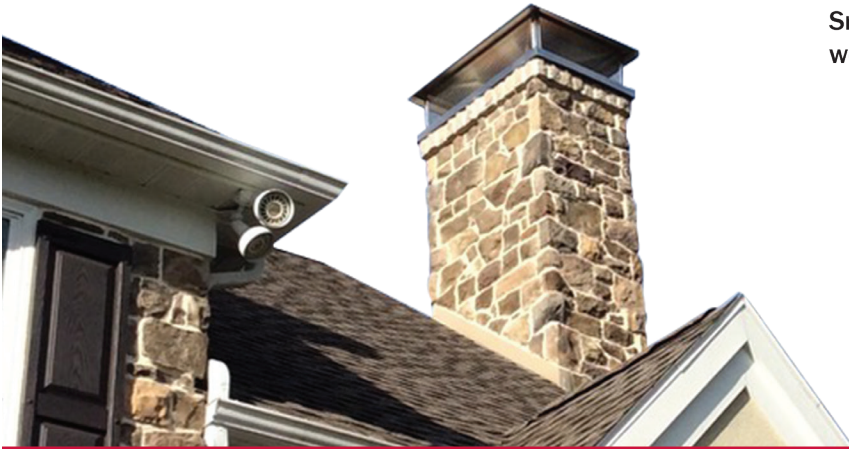

GOLF TIPS & TRICKS

MASTER YOUR SWING

VISUALIZE

As you take your practice swings, visualize where you want your shot to land. Take a breath and relax. Make sure your swing feels comfortable.

KEEP YOUR ARM CLOSE

Make sure your arm is as close to your hip as possible, with your elbow touching your hip. This will help you drive the club correctly to ensure the best impact on the ball.

BE SQUARE AND STEADY

Keep a steady posture. For optimal power and direction, hit the ball square with the clubface, attacking it on a downward angle.

USE YOUR CLUB CORRECTLY

Grip your club in your fingers—not the palms of your hands—and make it do the work. Focus on the middle of the ball, and control your swing carefully. You'll be rewarded with a more accurate and powerful shot!

RELAX

Relax your body, and don't grip your club too tightly. This will help you develop a faster swing release, which will result in a longer drive.

PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT

This is true of most things in life, and golf is no exception. Improve your skill level and technique by playing regularly.

PLANT YOUR FEET

Anchor your foot and body behind the ball. This is key to improving the distance of your shot.

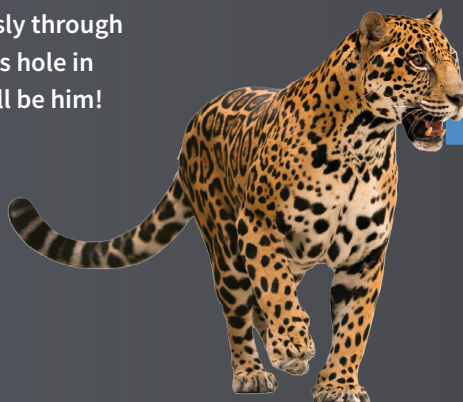


4 At that dinner party, the menu would definitely include his three favorite foods: lobster, sushi, and bacon.

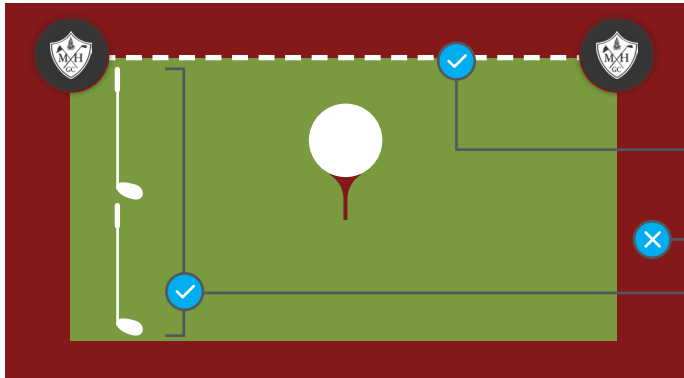
6 Conner recently lived vicariously through fellow Eagles fan Bob Stauffer's hole in one. He hopes one day that will be him!

WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

RULE 11: TEE SHOTS



THE GENERAL IDEA

- ✓ Changing your ball before playing your tee shot is allowed.
- Be sure to play your tee shot from both between and behind the tee markers.
- ✗ Do not play your tee shot from this area.
- You can play your tee shot from up to two club lengths behind the tee markers.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU PLAY YOUR TEE SHOT OUTSIDE THE ALLOWED AREA?

Match Play

- No penalty, but your opponent may require you to replay your stroke.

Stroke Play

- Two-stroke penalty.
- The stroke itself does not count.
- The ball must be played from within the correct area.
