
CONNER BARON


Conner recently lived vicariously through fellow Eagles fan Bob Stauffer's hole in one. He hopes one day that will be him!

WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

RULE 11: TEE SHOTS



THE GENERAL IDEA

- Changing your ball before playing your tee shot
 - Be sure to play your tee shot from both between and behind the tee markers.
- Do not play your tee shot from this area.
- You can play your tee shot from up to two club lengths behind the tee markers.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU PLAY YOUR TEE SHOT OUTSIDE THE ALLOWED AREA?

Match Play

• No penalty, but your opponent may require you to replay • Two-stroke penalty. your stroke.

Stroke Play

- The stroke itself does not count.
- The ball must be played from within the correct area.
