The management team and I are excited to start the 2024 season here at Meadia! A lot of work and improvements took place over the winter to improve your club experience.

Moving forward, we will base our tree work on the study's recommendations on a hole-by-hole basis, starting this year by focusing on 5, 10, 14, 15, and 16.

The off-season also brought some exciting tech upgrades to Meadia. Alpha Dog Advertising created a new website for us, and we introduced a new member portal. With a new mobile app and single sign-in, access to many features will enhance your club experience. These changes are not easy and affect all aspects of our club, so we are doing our best to make the transition as seamless as possible. TURF TALK

It's finally here — springtime at Meadia Heights! Just smell that fresh-cut grass. This winter we had a few snowstorms and some wet days, but that didn't slow down the maintenance crew one bit. We hired Kole Martin as a second superintendent, and he's made a big impact already! Here is a list of the projects our crew completed over the off-season:

- Renovated the 12 green complex
- Renovated the 13 bunker sod face
- Installed pavers around cart paths
- Finished track mats at cart path edges
- Installed steps and railings
- Removed debris on holes 5, 12, 15, and 18
- Replaced the 8 bunker
- Put sod farm in place
- Expanded the gold tee on 1
- Completed tree work and chipping
- Ground down 100+ tree stumps
- Cleaned out the 15 “dump”
- Cleaned the drain leading into 18 pond
- Laid riprap on 6

We hope these course improvements make your Meadia Heights experience even better. Here's to another great season!

In October 2023, Shreiner Tree Care of King of Prussia performed an evaluation of Meadia Heights' golf course, assessing the health of its trees and their effect on its playing surfaces. The company inspected each tee, fairway, and green for encroaching limbs, deadwood, and especially how the tree canopy affects the amount of sunlight reaching the putting greens — a vital factor in their overall health.

Shreiner compiled a report aimed at improving the amount of sunlight reaching the turf, enhancing playing conditions, boosting tree canopy health, and improving the overall safety of our golf course. Their recommendations included:

- **Thinning the tree canopy on 1, 4, 5, 8, 10, 11, 15, 16, and 17**
- **Removing overhanging or crowded limbs on 3, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, and 17**
- **Removing dead, diseased, and decayed branches on 6, 10, 11, 15, 16, and 17**
- **Removing more than 100 dead, declining, or otherwise hazardous trees throughout the course**

Golf Course Superintendent Ryan Grady used these recommendations to guide tree maintenance over the off-season. We will continue to monitor our course's trees to ensure optimal — and beautiful — playing conditions for all of our members and guests.

Vodka Lemonade Fizz

INGREDIENTS

2 oz Hanson of Sonoma Meyer lemon vodka

1/2 oz fresh lemon juice

1/2 oz simple syrup

1-2 oz club soda

Lemon slice for garnish

Sparkling sanding sugar (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Optional: For extra sweetness and an elevated aesthetic, rim your glass with sparkling sanding sugar. Run a lemon wedge around the rim, then dip it in the sugar to coat.
2. Pour vodka, lemon juice, and simple syrup into a cocktail shaker filled with ice, and shake.
3. Strain the shaker into your ice-filled glass.
4. Top it up with club soda.
5. Garnish with a slice of lemon.



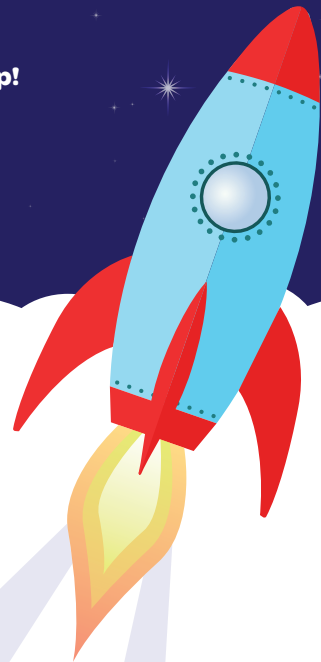
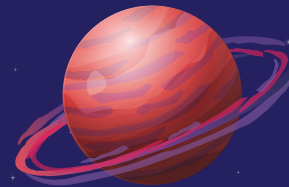
