



BEHIND THE GREENS

WITH BOBBY

Hello everyone, and happy spring!

We actually had a winter this winter. Even for me, coming from Long Island, the past three years we've seen little to no snow. This year, almost 12" fell throughout the winter months, but our team made the most of the dry and non-snow-covered days on the course.

Outside of normal winter maintenance like sanding and staining benches and cart signage, we were able to do a lot of tree work. Upland Tree Service came in on a bitter cold day in December and took down some dying, but mostly encroaching, trees on #15 tee, #14 green area. Rubio's Tree Service then did the same on #3, behind #2 green, and on the player's left side of #7. They also trimmed up the sycamore in front of #4 green, and the large oak left of #7 green. Our goal was to take out dying and dead trees first, then remove some that were becoming problematic for playing conditions.

We also cleared the woods left of #12 and behind #15 green. By doing this, we cleaned up an in-play wooded area, removed a bunch of debris that had collected over the years, and exposed several rocky outcrops, greatly improving views of that part of the course. Our last step is to have Hummer Turfgrass hydroseed the bare soil with tall fescue. Once this grows in, we'll have an awesome contrast of lush green rough flowing into a clean grove of trees, with golden brown fescue underneath the tree canopy.

As spring carries on, we'll be sodding bunker edges that have become inconsistent and problematic and cleaning and resetting them for consistent playability. We also plan to slightly raise the transitions from cart path to grass on certain holes to create smoother driving as you enter or exit.

Coming out of winter, I feel really good about the course conditions and everything our team has accomplished. I'm confident we'll be able to parlay this great start to an even better golfing season, and I look forward to seeing everybody out on the course!

Tyler's Old Fashioned with a twist

Old Fashioneds aren't old, they're classic. Try this new take on the beloved cocktail, from the creative mind of our Beverage Manager, Tyler.

Ingredients

3 oz bourbon

(Blanton's, Buffalo Trace, Basil Hayden Dark Rye are a few of my favorites.)

1 oz Italian sweet vermouth (I prefer Antica Formula.)

Orange slice

2 Amarena cherries

4-5 dashes spiced orange bitters

1-2 dashes Angostura bitters

1 tsp cherry syrup (from the jar of cherries)

Large ice cube

Large piece of orange peel

Steps

- In a rocks glass, muddle the orange slice and one cherry with spiced orange and angostura bitters. Add cherry syrup.
- 2. Add ice cube. Pour vermouth over the ice, then stir.
- 3. Add bourbon.
- 4. Flame the orange peel with a torch until zest catches fire and peel starts to blacken.
- Squeeze peel over the drink, then use it to rim the glass. Add the peel and one cherry to the glass as garnish.
