# GLOBAL WARMING

*As the ice melts, this margarita gets hotter and hotter. Make the spicy ice spheres at least a day ahead of time for maximum impact.*

## SPICY ICE SPHERES

*Makes approximately four spheres in a typical mold.*

### INGREDIENTS

- 1.5 qt water
- 2 jalapenos
- 2 Fresno peppers
- 1 habanero pepper
- 1 serrano pepper
- 4 sprigs fresh basil
- 3-4 oz agave syrup

### STEPS

1. Bring water and peppers to a boil for 30 minutes.
2. Remove from heat, add basil and agave syrup, and let it all steep to mingle the flavors.
3. Once cool, strain the liquid into an ice-sphere mold and freeze for 24 hours.

## GLOBAL WARMING COCKTAIL

### INGREDIENTS

- 2 oz reposado tequila
- .75 oz plum simple syrup
- 3 oz sour mix

### STEPS

1. Salt half the rim of your glass and drop in an ice sphere.
2. Shake tequila, simple syrup, and sour mix in an ice-filled shaker.
3. Pour drink over the ice sphere and garnish with fresh basil and a pepper slice.

## Goodbye, Old Friends

Because Meadia's stately trees are such a prominent feature of our club, removing them is never an easy decision. However, in the name of safety and improving playing conditions, we had to say goodbye (and, in some cases, good riddance) to a few of our old friends this winter. Here's where the course will look a little different this year.



### Right Side of #5

To boost the health of surrounding trees, we thinned the pine line in this area. We also removed several dying trees, including two oaks and two locusts.



### Right Side of #7

Sadly, we lost two majestic oaks here. They had little leaf canopy last summer, and were found to be diseased.



### Back of #13 Green

Less sadly, we're also removing the walnut trees that make a mess here every summer, as well as a few other trees that had begun to rot. (Hopefully by the start of the season, weather depending.)

# BEHIND THE GREENS

WITH BOBBY



Happy spring and welcome back! It was another cold, snowy winter, but several snow-free stretches allowed us to tackle our off-season work. The crew continuously exceeded my expectations, working hard to improve our course and build on the success that we've recently seen.

### Aim for the Target!

One exciting update is at the driving range, where the new target greens are growing in nicely. These were created using plugs from greens and tee aeration, and once fully established, they'll look like our greens and provide a better target to aim at when you're practicing.

### Bunker Makeovers

You'll also notice changes to several bunkers. All wooden bunker walls have been removed. The ones on 5 and 6 were rebuilt with stacked sod, while the bunker on 16 was removed entirely and replaced with a grass bunker. During this process, we made the bunker on 5 a touch wider and enlarged the forward bunker on 16 to accommodate the loss of the skinny bunker left of the green.



### Larger Tees

We completed several tee projects as well. The gold tees on 6 and 14 were expanded, with the work on 14 also lowering the tee. Now, your view of the fairway is no longer obstructed when teeing off from the white tees. The silver tee on 18 was enlarged and leveled, and the blue tee on 1 was regraded into a single level. We also added a new forward (gold) tee on 16, about 40 yards uphill from where it is currently. Although it's still a slightly challenging uphill tee shot, gold tee players shouldn't have to drive it all the way up the hill anymore, as was needed in the past.

All this tee work created waste soil, which we moved to the right side of 15, an area with no grass and a bunch of exposed tree roots. We'll be seeding fine fescue there to cover those roots and create an area of playable grass.

### Healthier Trees

Lastly, we continued thinning overcrowded tree lines, particularly on holes 3, 5, and 14, and addressed several dying or hazardous trees throughout the course. All removed trees will have their stumps and surface roots ground, filled, and seeded for a clean, finished look.

Overall, we're in a great position heading into the season. I'm excited to see the course green up, and I look forward to seeing you all out enjoying it very soon!

# A Great Club Starts with **YOU**

We know you take pride in your Meadia Heights membership and want the club to look and operate at its best. By pitching in with a few simple steps, we can all help to keep our grounds and golfing experience pristine.

## WELCOMING GUESTS

We love seeing new faces at Meadia! When hosting guests on our golf course, please:

- Make sure they wear proper attire as described on the Guest Information page of our website.
- Check in at the Golf Shop before your round.
- Be kind and courteous. Keep your round under four hours, and if driving, follow the cart rules (see Smart Carting below).
- Afterward, be sure to stop at the 19th Hole to toast your guests and introduce them to other Meadia members!

## SMART CARTING

Golf carts can cause significant damage to the course. Please help our grounds crew by observing the following:

- Drive on cart paths wherever and whenever possible!
- Keep all four wheels of your cart on the cart path at all times.
- Do not drive onto the tees or greens, or into bunkers, water features, or other restricted areas.
- Follow all cart sign directions.

**Handicap Flag Exception:** Golfers who qualify for a handicap flag may be allowed to access restricted areas around greens and bunkers, and to drive on fairways, as needed. However, restrictions still apply:

- Carts must stay on paths when parked at tees.
- Carts may not be driven into roped areas.
- Carts may not be driven into non-irrigated areas.
- Able-bodied golfers riding with a disabled golfer must walk to their ball when it's in an off-limits area.
- If more than one disabled person is in the group, they must ride together.

## REPAIRING DIVOTS

Getting under the ball often means taking a bit of sod with it. It's an expected part of the game. After making a divot on the course, please take the following steps to fill it:

1. Find and replace the displaced sod.
2. Step down firmly on the entire divot to settle it back into the earth.
3. Pour divot sand mix around the edges, then step down on the divot again to smooth it all out.

On the driving range, use the "bacon strip," or linear, method. Hit shots in a straight line behind the previous divot to conserve turf and help our grounds crew.

## FIXING BALL MARKS

Ball marks are another natural byproduct of play. Here's how to fix them correctly:

1. Use a forked or straight-line ball mark repair tool. If you have neither, grab a golf tee.
2. Insert the repair tool behind and away from the ball mark at a 45° angle.
3. Gently push the turf over the center of the mark.
4. Fill in around the ball mark until it's fully covered. Do not lift and twist the tool! This will damage the turf.
5. Use your putter to lightly pat down the covered mark.
6. As a courtesy, fix any other marks you see nearby.

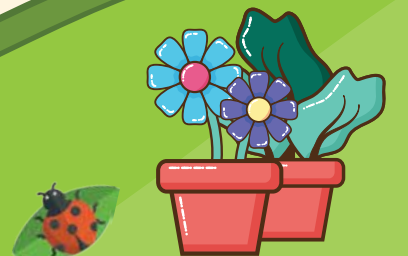
